Look at historical injury trends and try to implement controls that will address the injuries that occur

most often. If slip and falls quent injury work surfaces, fall protection, slip resistant shoes, and overall housekeeping.

Always maintain good housekeeping in the work areas. Inspections on work conditions should be done to help control hazards and reduce these instances.
